The issues identified reflect the actual votes taken by incumbent Congressmen, revealing their values on a number of issues important to your church members. If neither candidate is an incumbent (as is the case in some races), then issues were identified or derived from both candidates' campaigns or previous governing history.

My friends, attorney Mat Staver of Liberty Counsel and Jay Sekulow of ACLJ have advised pastors repeatedly that churches may freely distribute non-partisan voter guides without running afoul of IRS rules for non-profits, so long as the voter guides report actual history on several issues (as ours does) and do not endorse or oppose candidates (as ours does not). Please take heart, fear not, and boldly defend freedom by informing your people.

Now is the time to make your people aware of the voting record of your elected representatives. Please don't wait, especially considering early voting options for some.
