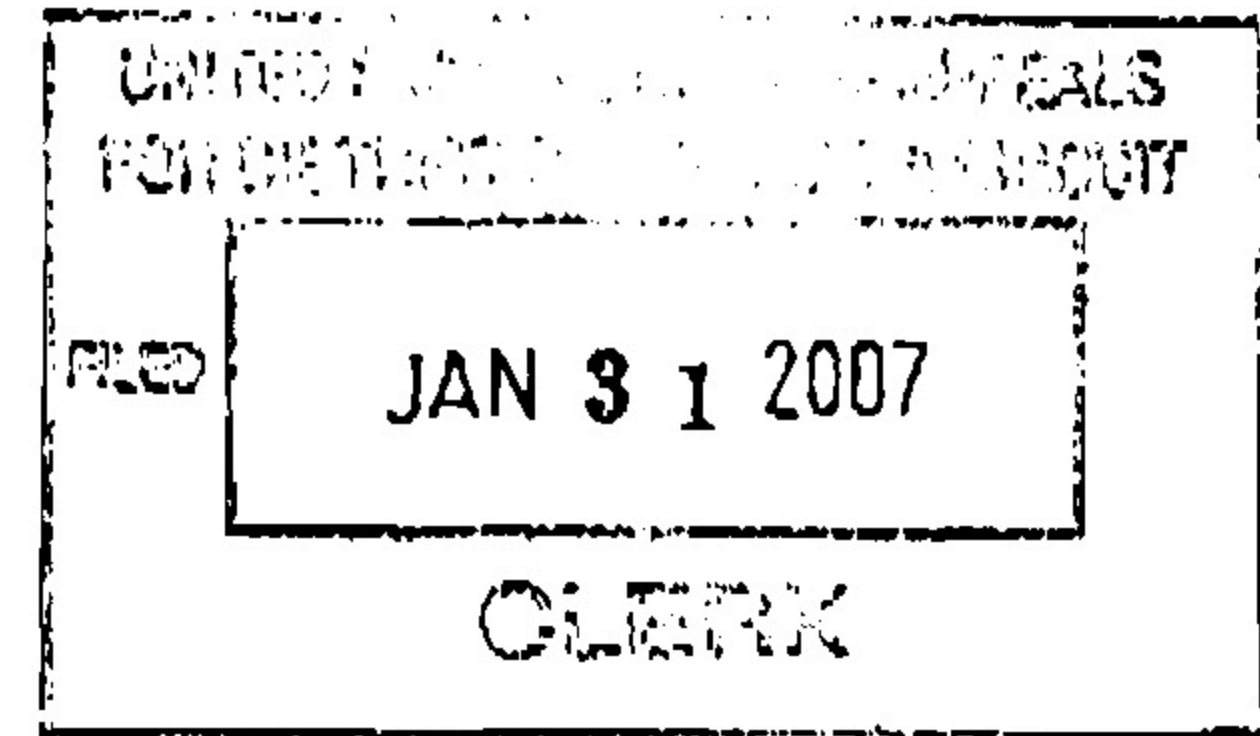

**ORDER**

Upon consideration of the emergency motion for an injunction pending appeal, it is

**ORDERED** that appellee is enjoined from effectuating appellant's separation from the Navy pending further order of the court.
